About Us

Our vision is for a Waterloo Region where everyone belongs – where we value meaningful relationships, honour choices and dreams, and celebrate the uniqueness of each person.

Originally called Facile: Independent Facilitation Waterloo Region, we were launched as an initiative of The New Story Group in 2010 to assist people with disabilities and their families to plan for and build a good life in the community.

In 2016 we changed our name to Bridges to Belonging Waterloo Region, to reflect our continued focus on building a community where everyone belongs.

Through Planning and Facilitation, we support people with disabilities, mental health challenges, and other barriers to full inclusion, to name and build on their abilities, and create the life they want in the community.

In the past two years, we have expanded the number of families we serve from 30 to 130. We have also added new programs such as Creative Housing Supports, a parent support group, and our innovative We Belong Waterloo Region campaign. Our hard work is paying off: in a survey, our program participants reported a 62% increase in their happiness and life satisfaction compared to when they started working with us.

By supporting people facing barriers to a full life in the community, we are improving the health and wellbeing of individuals by helping them realize possibilities. We are building a community of belonging for all.

About: Each year, we have over 100 people purchase tables or tickets to attend this event. Professional jazz musicians entertain the audience, interspersed with presentations from Bridges to Belonging participants. Funds for our organization are further raised through a silent and live auction.

What's New: This year we will be hosting the event in March, 2018, and again using the beautiful venue of THEMUSEUM. This ensures our event is fully accessible and there is space for a large number of guests.

EVENT SPONSORSHIPS

About: 3 films will be screened at the Princess Twin Cinemas in the fall, winter, and spring of 2017/2018. Between 75 and 100 people typically attend each event, where we screen inspirational and thought-provoking films that spark discussion about what inclusion means for us and our community. An honoured guest is invited for each event to share their thoughts and perspectives.

How You Can Help: There are a few ways you can help make the Inclusion Film Series a success:
